His Eminence, while Archbishop of St. Louis, founded and built the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, WI, and dedicated this Shrine on July 31, 2008; he has served the Holy Catholic Church always with courage, charity, confidence and Truth. His Excellency was the first American to be appointed (by Benedict XVI) Prefect of the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura, and most recently was elevated as a new member of the College of Cardinals by His Holiness Benedict XVI (November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010).

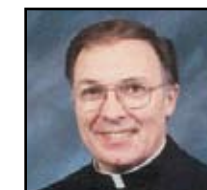
